Instructions to Applicants

Best Published paper (Early Career) \$5,000

CALHN Research Services is pleased to invite applications for the 2023-2024 Simpson Prize for Cancer Research. The award recognises outstanding research undertaken at the Royal Adelaide Hospital or SA Pathology and will be presented for the best published paper by an early career researcher.

Eligibility

- Eligible applicants must have published a paper as first author in a peer reviewed journal within the past two years (July 2021 - June 2023). Online publications, and articles accepted for publication within the date range are eligible for consideration. Proof of acceptance will be required.
- Applicants must be a CALHN employee and employed by either the RAH or SA Pathology.
- The applicant must have less than 8 year's postdoctoral experience.
- The published paper must reflect work performed within the Royal Adelaide Hospital, SA Pathology or Adelaide BioMed City.
- Applicants who have published more than one paper can submit one application per paper.
- A one off payment of \$5,000 will be made to the successful applicant(s).

Conditions of Award

- The award may be considered to be taxable income by the Australian Taxation
 Office and it is recommended that the recipient seek professional advice in this
 regard.
- To accept the prize, the prize winner will be required to complete the relevant finance forms. Contact: <u>Health.CALHNResearchGrants@sa.gov.au</u>
- A brief lay-summary of the paper must be provided to CALHN Research Services,
 Grants team for reporting and promotional purposes.

Selection

Applications will be assessed by the CALHN Research Scholarships and Fellowships Review Panel. Awards will be made by the Health Services Charitable Gifts Board.

The paper must identify the Royal Adelaide Hospital and/or SA Pathology in the author's affiliation. The Selection panel will take into consideration:

- Journal impact
- Number of authors
- Clinical relevance
- Scientific Merit



Application Guidelines

The completed application should be provided in the following format:

- Name and address of applicant, and department/laboratory in which they are located
- Title of the article
- Authors (as listed as per the publication)
- Journal title
- Date of publication and acceptance
- 200 word statement on the impact of this paper in the field
- Impact factor of the Journal
- Brief lay summary (for reporting/promo purposes)
- Copy of the published paper (including abstract) as an attachment
