Central Adelaide Local Health Network Parties and Signatories to Research Agreements

Overview

It is imperative that the parties to a Clinical Trial Research Agreement are properly identified to ensure that the correct legal entities are bound by the contract. This document outlines the correct business title and address for Central Adelaide Local Health Network (CALHN), who is and is not able to sign off the agreement and details of the contracting party.

CALHN Business Title & Address

For all CALHN Agreements, the correct legal entity is as follows:

Central Adelaide Local Health Network Incorporated (ABN: 96 269 526 412) Royal Adelaide Hospital, Port Road, Adelaide, South Australia 5000

Other Party

The other party to the contract may be a Sponsor, a CRO acting as a Local Sponsor, or a Collaborative or Cooperative Research Group (CRG). These parties may be various types of legal entities (e.g. proprietary company, company limited by guarantee, not-for-profit incorporated association, university or statutory body).

It is very important to independently verify the correct name and type of entity with whom CALHN is contracting, usually by doing an ASIC company search or other searches.

Signatories

A CALHN agreement must be signed off by an authorised officer on behalf of their organisation e.g. Chief Executive Officer/Chief Operating Officer/Executive Director/Executive Director of Medical Services or appropriate delegate.

Note: Principal Investigators, Clinical Trial Coordinators, Business Managers or Heads of Departments <u>do not</u> have the legal authority to sign research agreements on behalf of CALHN.

The Principal Investigator, though named in Schedule 1 to the Medicines Australia Agreements, is not a party to the Clinical Trial Research Agreement. However, the Principal Investigator must sign to <u>acknowledge</u> the obligations the Agreement imposes.



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
