Description of Service:

The Cardiology unit provides specialised assessment and surgical care of patients with problems of the cardiovascular system.

Services Provided:

- > Ischaemic heart disease
- > Coronary heart disease
- > Arrhythmias
- > Pacemakers
- > Rapid access chest pain clinic
- > Structural heart conditions / TAVI
- > Pulmonary hypertension
- > Heart failure
- > Hypertension
- > ECG, echocardiography, Exercise tests, holter monitoring

Exclusions:

- > Paediatrics
- > Patients receiving care for the same condition at another LHN.

Essential Referral Content:

Demographic

- > Date of birth
- > Contact details (including mobile phone)
- > Referring GP details
- > Interpreter requirements
- > Medicare number

Clinical

- > Reason for referral
- > Duration of symptoms
- > Relevant pathology and imaging reports
- > Past medical history
- > Current medications



Adult Triage Criteria for referral
