Spinal Outpatient Services Clinical Information Sheet

Clinical Condition	Spinal disorder with associated red flags
Eligibility	Spinal Pain +/- limb symptoms, or limb symptoms of suspected spinal origin accompanied by red flags Refer to Red Flag summary
Pre-referral management	 Investigate for red flags as appropriate. Screening may include: XR, CT Scan, MRI, CPE (ESR, CRP), WBBS Analgesia recommendation/prescription as appropriate
Priority	URGENT Refer patient immediately to the Spinal Outpatient Clinic with copies of investigation findings. Clearly mark referral as urgent and confirm receipt of referral (Fax. 08 7074 6247) If IMMEDIATE (same day) consultation is required refer patient to the Emergency Department and/or contact the Spinal Fellow/Registrar at the RAH via switch: Tel. (08) 7074 0000
Investigations required with referral	Include copies of all relevant investigation findings (as suggested in pre- referral management above)
Discharge Criteria/information	Discharge after investigation and management as required
